### ABSTRACT

Since 2011, the TROPA group at Complutense University of Madrid (Spain) has collaborated with Cheik Anta Diop University of Dakar (Senegal) in scientific collaboration, teaching, and technological innovation. This collaboration has resulted in several scientific articles, co-direction of doctoral theses, and participation in projects. The teaching collaboration between the two institutions has involved the exchange of professors to teach undergraduate and master's degree courses and co advising of several master thesis. Additionally, both institutions have established a meteorological observation network, UCadMet, which is yielding positive results. This seminar will cover the scientific, logistical, and cultural aspects of this long-standing collaboration, including lessons learned, achievements, and future challenges.
